Approved Attendance Systems

All providers who accept child care subsidy payments will be required to use an electronic attendance system by July 1, 2018. DEL has purchased a system from vendor Controltec, which is free for providers to use, or providers may select another DEL-approved system.

We are currently reviewing many systems to determine if they are in compliance with the DEL attendance tracking requirements. If you are using an electronic attendance system and don't see it listed below, please e-mail electronic.attendance@del.wa.gov with your name and SSPS #, as well as the name of your attendance system and the company that provides it and we will check to see if the system is in compliance with the attendance tracking requirements.
